"Rhetorical devices in political speeches"

Although political speeches represent a popular choice of topic, this investigation is given a sharp focus by the candidate's decision to compare the inaugural addresses of two different presidents. The context for the investigation is thus clearly established in the introduction and the subsequent background chapter, and the essay then moves swiftly into a detailed examination of each of the speeches chosen for study. Essays on media topics often tend to stop short by simply describing content, but here the analysis concentrates carefully on the rhetorical devices used and their persuasive and/or inspirational effect on the audience, suitable for an effective use of evidence.
